VIRTUAL SCHOOL PROJECT

The school is stepping up our supervision on the Virtual School Project. As we have reiterated severally in the past. Children's response and attitude towards the Virtual School programme has been very discouraging yet the Virtual School programme is a concept that was carefully planned to keep our students engaged in constant study and research during recess. To help change our students' attitude and sustain this laudable innovation of the school, the Academic Board in collaboration with the Virtual School Team are making all academic projects (including that of the Virtual School) form 10% of the total school score and will significantly affect the students' performance in the trimester exam. Parents' involvement is necessary to encourage students to take the Virtual School Project and all other academic projects seriously.

DEPARTMENTAL PROJECT

Angels School is revisiting our very academic exercise that was very helpful to the students of Angels some years past; and that is DEPARTMENTAL ACADEMIC PROJECT.
