THIS TRIMESTER

We look to have a very busy trimester; one that will serve as a ‘drive’ towards excellence and success. Management will inject a new sense of urgency in all school programmes.

We shall work towards the completion of our curricula for students in the examination classes; Cambridge Year 6, Year 8, Year 9, Year 11 and GES Grade 9 (JHS 3). ENROLMENT OF ALL FINAL YEAR CANDIDATES IN ANGELS BOARDING HOUSE

Management requests all Parents and Guardians who have their wards in JHS 3 or the IGCSE class (Year 11) to enroll them in our first class boarding facility located in Community 22, Tema. We have subsidized the boarding fees as part of our commitment to see the candidates get well prepared for the afore-mentioned exams. **Management expects all JHS candidates to report to the boarding house by February 4, 2018.** All IGCSE candidates have up to February 27, 2018, to report. We shall hold evening and Saturday Classes in the boarding house. Parents of the candidates will be permitted to visit them on Sundays, preferably after church service. We are counting very heavily on the cooperation of all Parents in our efforts to have these candidates better prepared for the exams.

SPOONS

We should be happy if parents provide spoons to be used by their wards during lunch. The school Canteen will no longer provide spoons for that purpose. We count on your cooperation on this.

CLUB ACTIVITIES AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

We shall continue with our various club activities from Pre-School to Secondary. Please note that Tuesdays and Thursdays are club meeting days. It is compulsory for all students to participate and benefit from the clubs they are affiliated to. This demands PUNCTUALITY as the club activities begin at 7:00am and end by 8:00a.m.

ANGELS AIR FORCE CADET CORPS

We will like to encourage all parents whose wards are members of our Air Force Cadet Corps to try as much as possible and visit the accounts office to pay for the prescribed uniforms and accoutrements. The total cost of cadet trainee gear is GHØ200.00

ENFORCEMENT OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

Management will like to remind parents and guardians that we will pragmatically, but strictly, enforce the "rules and regulations governing your child/wards admission for the 2017/2018 Academic year". Every parent is supposed to have a copy of this document. Please try to familiarise yourself with the rules and regulations governing your ward and grant us the necessary cooperation.

LOCKING OF SCHOOL GATE

As part of the measures geared toward the enforcement of discipline and the promotion of quality academic work, we shall **COMMENCE LOCKING OUR GATES AT 8:30AM ON ALL SCHOOL DAYS.** Classes officially begin at 8:00am and it thus means all pupils should be in school before 8:00am. We will have a 30 minute grace period from the time classes begin. Pupils who come after 8:30am will be made to complete the late arrival form before they gain entry to their classes. Students who complete the late arrival forms on three occasions will be asked to go back with their parents on subsequent occasions. No car will gain access into the compound between 8:30 and 10:00am.

Please treat our staff at the gates with decorum and civility in case your child is locked out. We are hopeful that the commencement of this exercise will not create any rigmarole at the gates or within the premises of the school. In case you encounter any challenges or need any further clarification, you may call the Principal on 0244709726. We are counting very well on your cooperation.

SCHOOL FEES

It is becoming increasingly difficult to run the school very smoothly in the present economic condition when Parents either delay payment of fees or fail to honour their promise to meet our deadlines. It will interest Parents to know that a total of GH¢114,000.00 of last trimester's school fees are still in arrears. You may understand why we try to enforce our school fees payment policy **VERY STRICTLY**. Much as we admit that some of the decisions may be quite unfavourable or "harsh", we believe you would appreciate that there have been remote causes. We are human and have listening ears. However, some customers did not honour their promises in the past. We shall need Parents to live up to their financial obligations to keep the school in active business.
