






Financial Matters

As per the policy of the school, parents/guardians with ONE or TWO wards in the school are expected to **MAKE FULL PAYMENT (100%)** of their wards' fees by the re-opening of school. However, parents/guardians who have **three or more wards** in the school still have the option of paying 2/3rds (75%) of their total fees and the rest before the resumption of mid-trimester break.

As part of preparations for academic work for the term and beyond, careful thought has been given to raising standards at all levels.

With the Cambridge International Primary Checkpoint examinations behind us and the BECE beckoning to us from the not-too-distant horizon, we have had to put in place measures to ensure we achieve the optimum.

To get the most out of the pupil premium in the area of teaching and learning, we re-focus on targeted support for pupils who fall behind their peers in the classroom. Teachers will now devise approaches that enhance learning as well as test, that support the curriculum rather than distort it, and that pursue high standards in all areas of learning.


In the pre-school, the re-tooling of teachers has paved the way for a creative approach to teaching, reading and writing in the broader spectrum.
